The Honorable Discharge Military History for Corporal Richard Asbrock indicates he enlisted in Cincinnati, Ohio on the 16th of July 1942. Corporal Asbrock was wounded in action against the enemy 22 June 1944 while participating in action against the enemy at Saipan Island, Marianas Islands from 15 June 1944 thru 22 June 1944. As a member of the 4th Marine Division, he participated in action against the enemy at Roi and Namur, Kwajalein Atoll, Marshall Islands from 31 January 1944 thru 7 February 1944. Corporal Asbrock was Honorably Discharged 17 February 1945.
