CORPORAL, U. S. MARINE CORPS RESERVE
WORLD WAR II**

“KRAUS Jerry. Son of the late William and Frances Kraus. Brother of the late Margaret, Marie & Bill Kraus. Died July 30, 2009 Age 88yrs.

At the age of 21, Jerry Kraus enlisted at Cincinnati, Ohio on 28 August 1942 and was Honorably Discharged at Camp Pendleton on 25 December 1945. While Jerry was never wounded during his service as a Quartermaster Supplyman in World War II, the “Battles, engagements, skirmishes, and expeditions” on the reverse side of his Honorable Discharge reports that he “... participated in action against the Japanese on Tarawa; Saipan; Okinawa; and the Occupation of Nagasaki, Japan.”
