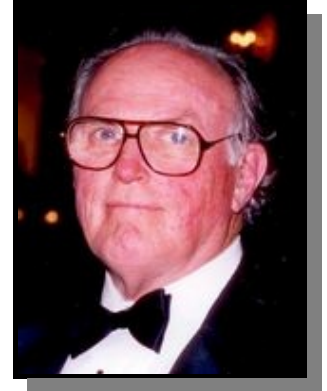

“Murrer, H. Scott Born July 10, 1931 in Cincinnati to Marie Hunt Murrer and Herbert Charles Murrer. From Elder High School, went on to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration at the Univ. of Cinti. and a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical and Electrical Engineering. He founded Modern Machinery Co., a distributor of high tech metal fabricating machinery, in 1959.

Diagnosed with Parkinson's disease in 1998, Scott continued to live and love life with humor, courage and steely determination with the support of his family and wonderful friends. He died peacefully at home on Saturday, February, 27, 2010, with his wife and family by his side. Scott was the beloved and devoted husband of Angela, proud father of Laura Murrer (Greg Jarvis), Linda Murrer (David Greener), Diana Murrer (T. Patrick Foy), H.
