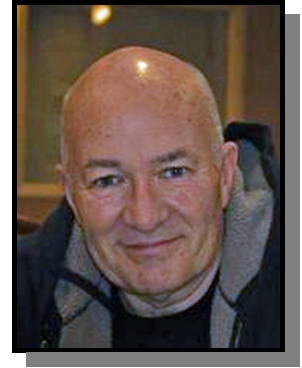




**JAMES ANDREW LUCIER “Top”
