“STATON, Lowell James 89, of Lebanon, OH died Saturday July 25, 2009. Born on July 23, 1920 in Newcastle, IN to Fred and Clara (nee: Wills) Staton, he was a member of Urbancrest Baptist Church. He enlisted in 1940 with the US 1st Marine Division, M Company, where he fought and was awarded a Presidential Unit Citation for his units performance at Guadalcanal and was discharged in 1946.

He was owner of Lowells Restaurant in 1960 in Stika, AK, built one in Colony Square in Lebanon, OH, and had 4 restaurants before retiring.

Preceded in death by his parents, survivors include his wife, Betty (nee: Clark) Staton of Lebanon, OH, sons, David Staton of Independence, KY and Stephan Staton (Melanie) of Redmond, WA, daughter, Sharon Hainline (Jerry) of Federal Way, WA, brother, Robert Staton of Dayton, OH, grandchildren, Jerrod Hainline (Megan), Stephanie Staton, Jerramy Hainline (Kassandra), and Benjamin Staton (Chantelle), and 6 great grandchildren.
